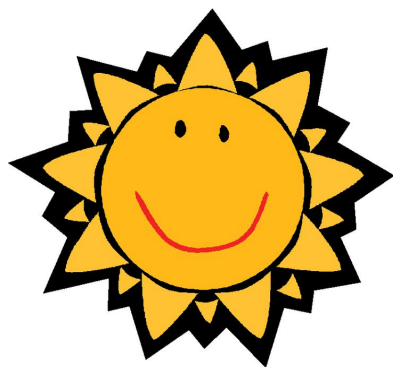


Parents' Afternoons
