Active Travel



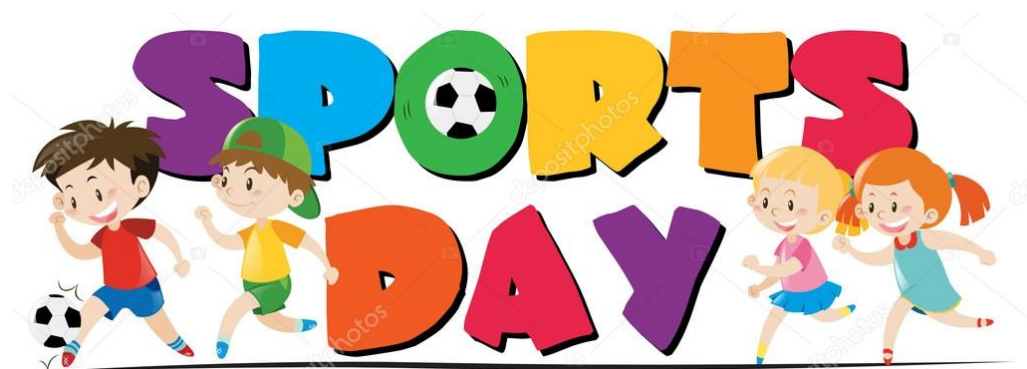
